ADMISSION TO TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION PROCESS

The purpose RBH is processing your information is: to accommodate new resident(s) into temporary accommodation, once referred by the Homelessness Central Assessment Team.

Our legal basis for doing this is: that it is necessary for the performance of a contract.

The additional legal basis for processing protected categories of personal information is: to comply with Social Protection Law.

As part of this process the following information may be shared with us: your Criminal Record, Immigration Status Eligibility, Contact details, National insurance Number, Next of Kin emergency Contact Details, Employer details/employment income, Details of any DWP/HMRC benefit Income, Proof of Identification and proof of income, Caring responsibilities, Marital Status, Disabilities or vulnerabilities.

By: Rochdale Borough Council (RBC) Homlessness Emergency Duty Team, Greater Manchester Police and/or other Government bodies.

You are required to provide us with this information by: non-secure licence agreement.

As part of this processing, your personal data may be shared with: Housing Benefits, Benefits Agencies NHS medical professionals.

All processing of your personal information will remain with in the UK.

Your personal information will then be kept on our records for: a period of 6 years from the end of your tenancy. Information from any other agencies will be deleted at the end of your stay.

You have a number of rights which we have to respect. One of these is a right to see all your personal information that RBH processes. For more information on your rights and for further information on how RBH protects your personal information, please see the RBH Privacy Statement.

If you are unhappy with how RBH processes personal information you may complain to the UK's regulator, the <u>Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)</u>.
