The additional legal basis for processing protected categories is: to comply with Employment Law.

As part of this process the following information may be shared with us: contact information, next

of kin, employment history, criminal records

By: the Job Centre, employment support agencies

As part of this processing your personal data will be shared with: Employment support agencies.

All processing of your personal information will remain with in the UK.

Your personal information will then be kept on our records for: 6 years from end of the

volunteering arrangement, 12 months if unsuccessful.

You have a number of rights which we have to respect. One of these is a right to see all your personal information that RBH processes. For more information on your rights, and for further
